

Ancient History News

Preliminary Ancient History is currently studying Archaeology. So on Friday 25th November, they conducted their own archaeological dig in the long jump sand pit. First they partitioned off their site with pegs and rope using the grid system. They were then given tools similar to what is used on archaeological digs such as, trowels, brushes, sieves and even toothbrushes for the finer brushing. They had fun digging in their own allocated grid searching for bones which had been put there previously - but also found many things that were not put in there deliberately. When the students put the bones on the sorting table they rightly identified them as a cow. It was a great afternoon of hands-on learning, giving the senior students a taste of an archaeologists life. Thank you to the Lyle family for supplying the cow bones, especially Kelsey and Bonnie who collected the bones in the paddock.
