**PRIMARY – YEARS 3 to 6**

- \* 1 x box or packet of Ball-point pen - **blue** (Years 4, 5 & 6) – *(Parents will be notified for resupply when packet is half empty - non-clickable, single colour solid pen that can not be dismantled)*
- \* 1 x box or packet of Ball-point pen - **red** (Years 3 to 6) – *(Parents will be notified for resupply when packet is half empty - non-clickat single colour solid pen that can not be dismantled)*
- \* 1 x box or packet of HB pencils - **standard size quality pencils** – *(Parents will be notified for resupply when packet is half empty - ask that you please avoid purchasing extra long, fat or odd shaped pencils etc)*
- \* 1 x Pencil sharpener
- \* 1 x 4pk Glue stick - Parents will be notified for resupply when packet is half empty
- \* Good quality coloured pencils
- \* Paint shirt to protect uniform - Clearly labelled
- \* Erasers (Art rubber) - Single piece, not novelty or dismantlable.
- \* Ruler – not bendable or metal, 30cm with cm & mm markings, without calculators or drawers
- \* Pencil case - convenient size (not too large)
- \* Textas – only for Years 3 to 6 and must be labelled
- \* 4 x Yellow highlighters
