



2024 SNOW TRIP – PACKING LIST

What to Bring

Students will need to bring the following gear with them on the camp:

- Warm** Clothes for the duration of the Trip, including:
 - Warm Long Pants (not jeans), Jumpers, warm shirts, underwear**
 - Thermal underwear (long-sleeved top and bottoms)
 - Water-resistant gloves (snow gloves, not knitted)
 - UV resistant/ polarized snow goggles (preferable) or sunglasses (should wrap around)
 - Warm Beanie or balaclava
 - Minimum 2 pairs long warm socks
 - Shoes for outdoors (may get wet – Boots/ gumboots can be a good option in the snow with proper socks)
 - Slippers/ Ugg boots/ indoor shoes
 - Comfortable clothes for travelling
- Towel
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Soap, Shampoo, **Sunscreen**, Deodorant (not aerosol), **Personal Medication**)
- Blistex or similar SPF rated chapstick** (a lifesaver!)
- Bedding: Sleeping bag and pillow (linen provided)
- Respectable PJs
- A spare/ old toothbrush (for Assassins game)**
- 2 litre water bottle (very important)
- Plastic Bags (to put any wet gear in when bringing it home to Casino)

Optional Gear you may wish to consider includes:

- Mobile Phone** and Charger (see notes)
- Neck Protector/ bandana/ scarf
- A **small** day bag to carry with you on the snow

Equipment included in package

- Ski Jacket, Snow pants, skis, boots, stocks and helmet



A Note on Appropriate Clothing

A reminder that when we are on camp it is important to dress appropriately – whether on the snow or at Ski Rider. You should try to plan each day's clothes before leaving home so that you don't take clothes you won't wear. Don't just pack all your favorite clothes; this is not a fashion show. It will be cold, so pack appropriately.

With that in mind, please do not bring:

- Tight shirts, singlet tops or shirts revealing the midriff
- Short shorts
- Any clothing bearing inappropriate slogans
- Jewelry (must not be worn during activities as a safety precaution)

What Not to Bring

- No Alcohol or Cigarettes
- No Spray Deodorants
- No Water bombs or fire crackers
- No soft drink, energy drinks (e.g. Mother, Red Bull, etc) or Coffee
- No Knives

This list is not exhaustive – please use your common sense.

Phones and Other Technology

Normal school rules apply to camp; however, students will be allowed to bring a phone to use as a camera and an emergency contact whilst on the snow.

If a student wishes to bring a phone, they do so at their own risk. **Any inappropriate use of a device will result in the phone being confiscated for the duration of the trip**, and appropriate discipline will be implemented in line with our discipline and electronic device policies.
